Thank you for your recent letter. I was glad to have the opportunity to meet with you during your trip to Washington, D.C.


I am concerned that you are still unable to obtain accurate financial information from the Marion Public Schools. I would urge you to continue to work with your state representative and state senator in Lansing as well as the Michigan Attorney General to investigate the misappropriation of state education funding.

I would also encourage you to share your concerns with the Inspector General of the Department of Education who investigates reports of misuse of federal education funding.
